Trunk or Treat

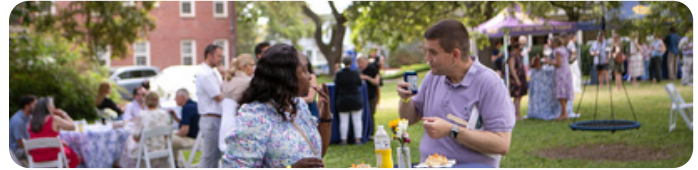
