Logistics

General Site Set-Up – Assist with setting up tables and chairs, moving items around the festival, filling and delivering water buckets, setting up volunteer and staff spaces. Must be able to lift 10 pounds.

Vendor Check-In – Check in vendors and lead them to their assigned spaces.

Participant Counter – Use a count clicker at different entry points of the festival to keep track of the number of guests arriving to the festival.

Volunteer Refreshments – Keep volunteer area tidy and pass out snacks and food to fellow volunteers.

Surveys – Ask participants about their experience at the festival.

General Site Breakdown – Assist staff with site cleanup. Must be able to lift 10 lbs.

House Museum Site Monitor – Greet visitors at the door of the Modjeska Simkins Site and monitor the number of people in the house at one time.

HC Shop and Info Table – Help pass out HC information and assist Shop Manager with purchases.

Tour Shepherd – Walk guests from the main festival area to the Modjeska Simkins House Museum one block away.
